- **Steelhead Fish Live Web Cam Link** - Below is the link to a live web cam of the Steelhead Fish in our science classroom. We put the eggs in the tank on Wednesday February 22<sup>nd</sup>. They are at the "eyed" egg stage. If you watch closely, you should be able to see the eyes move around a little bit. The fish should hatch out of their eggs by Monday, February 27<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>. At this point they will be at the alevin stage with the egg sack still attached. They will wiggle their way into the gravel and hide for about 2 weeks until most of the sack is absorbed by their bodies. Once absorbed, they will swim up out of the gravel and be small fry in our tank.
